

Notes on the Grand Staff

Treble Clef + Bass Clef = **The Grand Staff**

Tricks for Memorizing the Notes:

Treble clef LINE notes: Every Good Boy Does Fine

Treble clef SPACE notes: F A C E

Bass clef LINE notes: Good Boys Do Fine Always

Bass clef SPACE notes: All Cows Eat Grass

Other Important Notes:

-Finger numbers: the thumb is 1, index is 2, middle is 3, ring is 4, and the pinky is 5 for both hands.

-Notes that are higher or lower than the staff use ledger lines (like middle C).
