

Major 7th Chords on All Roots

(Memorize These!)

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1 C Δ 7 F Δ 7 G Δ 7

This block shows the first three chords: C major 7th, F major 7th, and G major 7th. Each chord is presented in a grand staff with treble and bass clefs. This block shows three pairs of tritone-related chords: E \flat Δ 7 / D \sharp Δ 7, G \flat Δ 7 / F \sharp Δ 7, and B \flat Δ 7 / A \sharp Δ 7. Each pair is presented in a grand staff. The first pair is in the key of E-flat major (three flats) and D-sharp major (three sharps). The second pair is in the key of G-flat major (four flats) and F-sharp major (three sharps). The third pair is in the key of B-flat major (two flats) and A-sharp major (three sharps).

10 B Δ 7 A \flat Δ 7 / G \sharp Δ 7 D \flat Δ 7 / C \sharp Δ 7

This block shows the final three chords: B major 7th, A \flat Δ 7 / G \sharp Δ 7, and D \flat Δ 7 / C \sharp Δ 7. Each chord is presented in a grand staff. The B Δ 7 chord is in the key of B major (two sharps). The A \flat Δ 7 / G \sharp Δ 7 pair is in the key of A-flat major (three flats) and G-sharp major (three sharps). The D \flat Δ 7 / C \sharp Δ 7 pair is in the key of D-flat major (two flats) and C-sharp major (three sharps). The piece ends with a double bar line.
